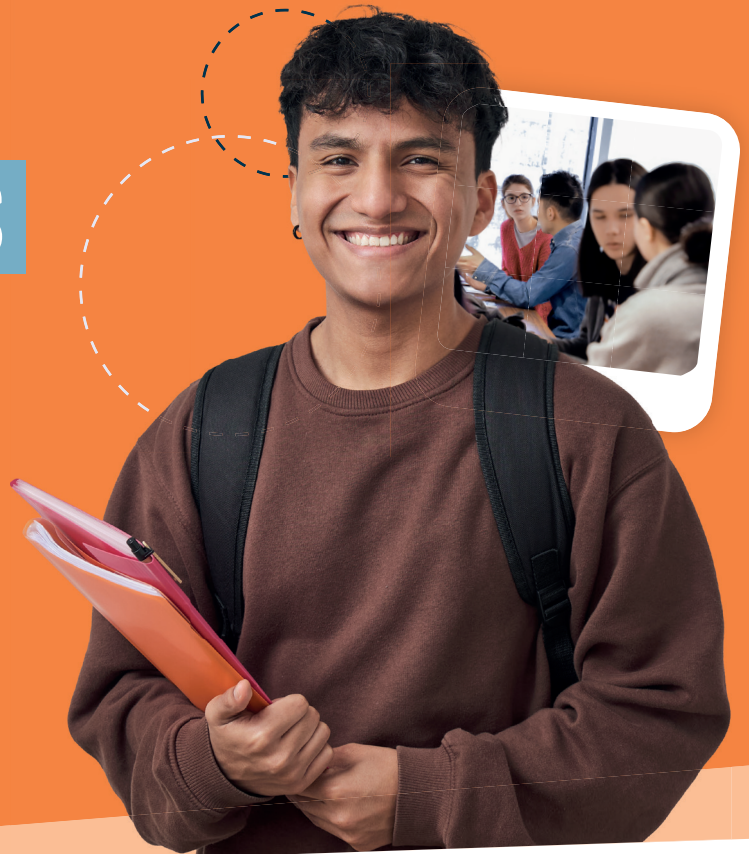


JOINT PATHWAYS AT ILSC LANGUAGE SCHOOLS CANADA

WHAT ARE JOINT PATHWAYS?

Similar to traditional Canadian University Pathways, Joint Pathways at ILSC Language Schools support students to meet the language requirement of Canadian higher education institutions.

Joint Pathways combine 3 learning steps, and students apply for one Study Permit for all parts of their pathway.



ILSC LANGUAGE SCHOOLS

STEP 1

Language study

4+ weeks | Full-Time¹, in person

Complete our University Pathway program, which focuses on English for Academic purposes. Build skills for success in Canadian higher education.

YOUR CHOSEN POST-SECONDARY INSTITUTION

STEP 2

Language study²

Length may vary by school

Complete your final level of English at your chosen post-secondary institution.

STEP 3

Post-secondary program

Length varies by program

Choose from certificates, diplomas, bachelor's degrees, or graduate-level qualifications.

² Some post-secondary institutions may offer the option to complete a limited number of credit courses at the same time as the language study component.

- ▶ Apply for just one study permit for your entire pathway (students use a Provincial Attestation Letter from the post-secondary institution, which covers the entire learning journey).

- ▶ Complete your final language level at your chosen post-secondary institution and get familiar with your new campus before diving into your post-secondary program.
